28.02.06.	Introduction session for Cog Skills with Jordan. Jordan had just come straight from a meeting with his Social Worker in which he was informed that his home leave is being withdrawn, not because of his behaviour, but because of issues with Mum. Jim came over with Jordan and filled me in on the situation, and also made Jordan aware that he had informed me of the circumstances, and that he was in no way to blame for what has happened. Jordan was initially reluctant to attend, however engaged well during the session. He was very quiet & withdrawn and clearly quite 'shell-shocked' after the meeting, however with prompting he did engage with the session, offering some good suggestions to the questions asked. Spoke about some of the anger triggers & signs in the video, and Jordan did make some links to his own reactions when he is angry. Quite reluctant to talk about the night's events, however did mention that he felt "annoyed", and took himself off to his room after being told of his leave being stopped. Returned to the unit still quite down, and headed straight to his room.	MG.

Explained we would still arrange an outing at the end of the programme, and Jim felt a tour of Parkhead was a good idea. Jim suggested raising this at Jordan's review on 9 March. Possibility SW may not agree, as additional funding has already been requested for additional staffing/resources at weekends due to leave being stopped.	
07.03.06	Session 1 scheduled for today but Jordan reluctant to attend. Jim managed to persuade him to discuss his concerns with me, and they arrived 30 mins later than scheduled time. Jordan felt that the programme was 'boring', however Jim and myself discussed ways of making it more interesting eg. including footballing examples. He ended up completing half of Session 1 (footballer) example and Jordan struggled to offer any input without some considerable prompting. He later
