

C.P.D. officers interviewed both [redacted] and [redacted] at 6 p.m. in the H. R.'s office. Both denied having committed any offence, stating that they had found the keys and won the money on the "puggies". They were both charged with breaching and theft.

[redacted] + [redacted] absconders, were apprehended by the Pollok Police and were brought back to the School by Mr. Roy and Mr. Windsor.

An internal review was held on [redacted]. Miss S. Wynd, student, was visited by her tutor from Dundee College of Education.

[redacted] phoned during the evening to say that he had reached the Bellahouston Hotel Paisley Road West and could not get any further as he had no money. He was told to make an effort to get back under his own steam if he was finding it difficult to phone again in a half an hour. Approximately two hours later there was a call from Craichan Children's Home saying that he had returned there. It was requested that he stay there overnight and return to school tomorrow morning. This was agreed.
