Numerous phone calls by Mr Neil and Mr Walker re [redacted] on mainly cent. over week-end, at Balornie school, after assault on Mr Wm Neil (Friday). Boy finally presented before Reporter (Emergency Panel) at 4.30 pm, and placed on 21 day warrant to Calder House Asst Centre, Blairgowrie. Taken there by LASW and mother (see notes). [redacted] granted D/Paw, on his 15th birthday. Extensions of leave granted to [redacted] and [redacted] (c/notes). All other boys back from leave. Pleasant evening in all three houses with Spats Hall, TV, video and home recreation.
