[redacted] has also moved into Dorm 4, but boy was given authority to do so by Mr Crawford. Alcohol was being consumed in [redacted]'s room earlier on in the night. At least 3 empty cans recovered. Mr Windsor, Mr Kerr, Mr Jenkins desperately needed to provide more support to basic ^{grade} staff in the W/H. A particularly difficult period seems to be from 4-5 pm. Consistency of approach is essential. Is [redacted] normally in the habit of receiving 20p. packet money each day?

There was a quiet start to the day. Mr Glen and Mr Kerr returned to duty after short periods of sick leave. Mr. Jenkins attended a Children's Hearing on [redacted], who is adrift from the school at the moment. He did not turn up for the hearing and a warrant was issued for his arrest.
