This right handed truck driver was on holiday in Holland when he was play wrestling with some mates. He injured his right hand at that time although the mechanism of injury was unknown. The date of injury was 20.09.12. He returned to Ayr on 26.09.12 and was only seen in A & E on this date. He was assessed, X-rayed and placed in a volar slab.

On examination out of the volar slab today, he does have some swelling over the base of the fourth metacarpal with localised tenderness. There is no rotational deformity or no neurovascular deficit.

Repeat X-rays taken today do not show any dislocation of the fourth carpometacarpal joint and no change in the fracture position.

I have therefore reassured him that the fracture will heal on its own accord and have given him a Futura splint for symptomatic splintage for the next week or 2. I have not made any arrangements to see him in the clinic again.
