Please be aware that these health records have been reviewed by a clinician and any information identifying or provided by a third party has been removed.

We process personal information to enable us to provide healthcare services for patients; support and manage our employees; to carry out research and clinical trials; maintain our accounts and records and to carry out data matching under the national fraud initiative. We also use CCTV systems for crime prevention.

This personal information can be both clinical and non-clinical in nature, and can include:-

- patient health records, photographs or Radiology images;

This pleasant young boy attended with viral warts on his hands, which have been present for months.

I gave them a trial of liquid nitrogen but unfortunately didn't tolerate this and refused any further treatment. I discussed this in detail with him and the carer that was with him. I have arranged to give him a 6 month open appointment and should he change his mind we could restart liquid nitrogen therapy. I have advised him to use topical treatment. It might be an idea, if he wants to proceed with liquid nitrogen again, that you gave him some Emla cream so that he could use this prior to liquid nitrogen therapy, however, at present I don't think he is particularly keen to pursue this.
