26.10.98 Outing with William	To Macdonalds. William keen to sit in the car and talk while eating ice cream. Very talkative. Spoke a little about school. Said he had lots of friends, but also that there was nothing he was good at at school except football. Seemed very conscious of his lack of educational achievement. Spoke about [REDACTED] and how much he misses him.
26.10.98 Meeting with Mr and Mrs [REDACTED] (respite carers), with Heather Russell (Resource Wkr)	Meeting with Williams respite carers. Extensive discussion of their experience with William. In [REDACTED] view William suffers from some form of global cognitive deficit which impacts both on his cognitive and moral development and will make further development very limited. She feels he has no sense of right or wrong, and confabulates, and gave examples. [REDACTED] had a less extreme view, but feels that William is already 'lost'. They described the incident that had taken place in April 1998 when William had made sexual advances toward [REDACTED]. They are now prepared to take William for monthly respite (weekend: one overnight). Full discussion re boundaries, discipline, supervision required to ensure the safety of [REDACTED] and appropriate behaviour from William. The couple have applied to adopt again, which will necessitate a further review of William's respite at some point.
3.11.98 Meeting with [REDACTED]	General discussion re William. [REDACTED] has concerns about Williams development, especially re educational achievement, which is approximately one year behind. Now in P3 and thinks Educational Psychology should definitely be involved, although to date the school and EP service have refused. [REDACTED] thinks he may be dyspraxic, and has requested an OT assessment, which will commence shortly. I advised [REDACTED] of my own concerns and intention that William should have a comprehensive assessment, of which OT could be part, with a view to a) making a clear decision about EP involvement b) providing a base line for any future therapeutic programme to address his sexualised behaviour c) to refocus permanent placement needs and provide clearer indications re identification of a suitable family. Commenced AAR.

Both LS teacher and Mrs Nicholl resistant to understanding the medical assessment provided by Dr Dewar and Maria Docherty, its likely impact on Williams learning ability, and unwilling to consider educational assistance to improve his learning opportunities. LS teacher made it very clear that she feels William is very disruptive and less 'deserving' of additional support and assistance than some other children. For instance she talked about him being 'dreadful' recently. [REDACTED] reminded her that she had advised the school about William's anxieties re the birth of his brother. It was clear that the teacher had forgotten this, or chose to discount it. Dr Dewar and myself insistent that a proper assessment required to judge whether he requires a Record of Needs, and to ensure that his needs take account of his home situation and history, are clearly documented, take account of the longer-term, and are transferable to a new school is William is placed elsewhere. Mrs Nicholl disagreed but advised she would inform DEPS of our concern. Case conference minutes inadequately document the content of the case conference.

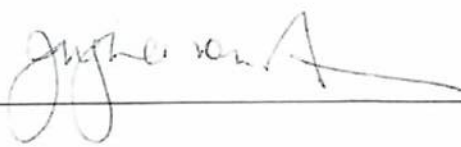

████ informed me, with William present, that she and William had had a long talk because of his deteriorating behaviour at school. William admitted that he is very anxious to see his brother █████ and about his mother and the new baby.

Continued the discussion in the car. I said to William that I would try to get a picture of █████ but I could not promise contact as it would not be my decision. I asked William to describe █████ to me. He described him in detail and said he looked "like █████".

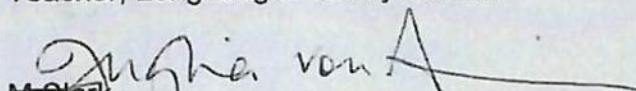
William also talked about his mother, and it was quite evident that much of his anxiety is about whether having the baby will make her sore and ill. Reassured him that Linda will be fine and that she will bring the baby to next contact.

Discussed the Children's Hearing on Wednesday. William is adamant that he wants to come, even if there are arguments. When asked why, he said "to see my dad". I explained that he would see his dad the following week, and this would not be the best possible meeting. Also explained that Linda would not be present because of the baby. I explained the purpose of the Hearing and what questions would be asked and why, and what everyone was likely to say, hence the possibility of disagreement.

William said he had been before. He wanted to tell the Panel that he wants to stay with █████ and maintain contact with parents as it is. Visited "Pets are Us" - William very excited. Had to be restrained from kicking balls around and warned about stealing dog food, which he put in his pocket very intentionally. (Informed █████ on return. Did "Magical Mystery Tour Home" with William navigating, which he enjoyed. He informed me he had a girlfriend called █████ also aged 7 years, whom he had kissed.

Discussed outing with █████ on return; William's behaviour, discussion today and school behaviour, suggest he has a great deal to think about and cope with just now. █████ said William had said exactly this to her a couple of days ago.

I gave █████ William's contact schedule with Mr Tarbett and copy letter to Mrs Nicholl, Head Teacher, Longhaugh Primary School.
