WILLIAM'S SUPERVISION ORDER WAS CONTINUED BECAUSE:-

- ① Miss ROBERTSON (Mum) STATED SHE WAS NOT IN A POSITION TO CARE FOR WILLIAM. SHE WAS SURE HE WAS BEING WELL LOOKED AFTER IN HIS PRESENT PLACEMENT.
- ② DESPITE BEING GIVEN ADVICE AND GUIDANCE ON MANY OCCASIONS, MR. TARBUIT REFUSES TO ACT UPON IT. (THIS ADVICE IS ABOUT IMPROVING HIS PARENTING SKILLS TO AN ACCEPTABLE LEVEL)
