I have been to our archive this morning to review the file we hold for Mr Carroll and would advise that the information held by Angus Council relates to his involvement with Angus' Justice Services.

I did however review one of his court reports to determine if there was any background information which would confirm his attendance in care.

The report detailed that Mr Carroll (also known as John Ewan Watt) was born and raised in Dundee by his grandmother prior to being placed in care.

This information was provided to the social worker compiling the court report by Mr Carroll.

As we have no childcare file for Mr Carroll, I would recommend that you contact Dundee City Council, who were also responsible for the unit Mr Carroll advised he was placed.
