Amanda was admitted into care in 1989 and has spent some time living with foster parents and at [REDACTED]. On Monday 10 May 1993 a Children's Hearing varied Amanda's supervision requirement naming [REDACTED] before ending up at Rossie on 25/05/94 due to Amanda's continual absconding.

### AGREED PLAN:

1. To arrange visits and leaves between mother and Amanda, hopefully ending up with a home base for her.
2. Try and get Amanda to mix with her peer group instead of sitting in her room so much.
3. Help Amanda regain her self esteem.
4. Encourage her in education.

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Amanda is currently residing in Rossie on a full 44(1)(b) order issued by the Children's Hearing Centre in Dingwall on 16.01.95. Because of Amanda's continuing pattern of absconding and putting herself at risk while on leave.

On 16 January, 1995 Amanda joined Tay Unit from Forth House (Rossie's open provision) it seems that Amanda feels she needs the comfort of a secure environment, a need to be told what to do and when to do it. Amanda at times shows a reluctance towards doing unit chores even just helping out. She is a moody and quite stubborn girl especially when things are not going her own way, taking herself off to her room to listen to music when inclined.

Amanda can when willing be a pleasant and cheerful girl who takes care of her appearance and tidies her room without much encouragement from staff. A girl of good health and appetite.

Educationally Amanda is a bright and capable girl, good in subjects such as Art, Crafts and Design, her only failing is in her behaviour towards her peers, going to and from class she has the ability of winding up others without a thought or care for their feelings in the hurtful remarks she makes.

Since joining Tay Amanda has enjoyed a day visit and four leaves home. The first of which unfortunately was due to the sudden bereavement of her grandmother. Amanda went up to Alness from 3 - 5.2.95 to stay with her father, this was a very successful leave which resulted in another leave from 17-19.2.95 to her fathers in Alness which went well again. Her next leave was a day visit to her mothers on 22 February, 1995 when Amanda was escorted by a member of staff who reported that the home situation was very pleasant and of good accommodation and surroundings for Amanda. On the weekend of the 25-26. February, 1995 Amanda went for an overnight to her mothers which appears to have gone well, she again went on leave to her mothers from 3-5 March, 1995 and again this appears to have went well, although

Amanda said she had lost her ticket for the return journey when she phoned up Rossie on Sunday. A member of staff had to go through to Leith to uplift Amanda, who has done this before whilst she was in Forth.

Amanda unfortunately is unsure at present what she would like to do after leaving Rossie and seems quite content to remain with us for the foreseeable future. However, Amanda has now been with us for many months and it is felt that a further period in Rossie would no longer be beneficial for her and the time has now come for her to move on perhaps to an establishment nearer to home; she clearly no longer meets the criteria for secure accommodation.

Since I've come to Rossie I've settled in a lot. I really feel better than I have for a long while. Rossie staff have helped me out with a lot of things that [REDACTED] and numerous other places haven't. I enjoy the school and I feel settled with the work and the help I get.

Though I've been here for a while I still feel there is a lot of work to be done and I think the staff here e.g. [REDACTED] are the ones to help me. All I've ever wanted was to have contact with my mum and they have helped me get to the first step and I

really hope they will help me to get further.

I don't feel [redacted] is the right place anymore because I don't feel it does me any good. My hopes for the future is to gradually start to get leave to see my mum and if everything goes well I would want to go down permanently.

My teachers are looking into a place at college and if I were able to move to Edinburgh for a fresh start I would want nothing more than a place in college in Edinburgh.

My mum goes to college and I would get a lot of extra help from her.

In all the time I've been in  
care I've been moved here  
and there, but now I've  
got the chance to be back  
with my family, I think it's  
the best thing that's happened  
in years.

I still feel I need another  
period of time in Rossie,  
to finish a lot of unfinished  
school work e.g. Science  
modules. And if I want things  
to work out for the future  
then these are the people  
to help me, I hope you  
understand what I think is  
best and be glad that I  
have made a decision  
at last, and that it is  
the right one.

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Initially when Mandy joined Forth House (Rossie's open provision) on 10.11.94 she was a little unsure of her new surroundings and the freedom that accompanied this, however, she settled quickly and adapted well.

Although she can at times be a bit reluctant to do household chores, she has presented no problems following the independent living programme implemented for her. This involves budgeting, shopping and preparing meals, amongst other general tasks. On the whole Mandy proves to be good company and fairly witty within Forth House, although can be stubborn and moody on occasion when things aren't going her way, the behaviour that most teenagers exhibit.

Mandy presents as a healthy girl with a good appetite and a high standard of personal hygiene. She continues to receive travel sickness pills before any journey, other than that she is on no medication.

Educationally Mandy is a bright and capable girl, excelling in subjects such as Art & Crafts and Design. [REDACTED] her educational co-key worker in Rossie, and [REDACTED] discussed the possibilities of Mandy attending college, they felt she had the ability to do so.

Mandy continues to maintain contact with her older sister, [REDACTED] who resides in Inverness, although this has not been regular weekly contact due to the differences between them on occasion.

More recently Mandy's father was in touch and she visited him and her sister over the Christmas period, whilst on leave at [REDACTED] This was a successful meeting.

On 5 January 1995 I took Mandy for a visit to her mother's home in Leith. They had not seen each other since Mandy was nine years old. Her three younger brothers and older brother were also in the house. The reunion appeared to be very successful; Mandy was accepted and welcomed by the whole family and at the end of the visit

was reluctant to leave. [REDACTED] (Mandy's mother) stressed that she was very anxious for her to return there and that she would really like to start taking Mandy for weekends with a view to having her at home permanently.

Leaves to [REDACTED] have continued throughout Mandy's stay in Rossie and although there have been breakdowns on occasional weekends it has been the ongoing plan that Mandy would go to [REDACTED] on a full time basis following her move on from Rossie. At her last local authority Review (16/12/94) it was decided by all concerned that the recommendation to the next Hearing would be that Mandy leave Rossie and return to [REDACTED] on a permanent basis.

The Hearing's decision on 11.1.95 was to return Mandy to Rossie, which pleased her as she had written a letter to the Panel members requesting more time here.

Initially Mandy return to Forth House and the plan was to continue leaves to Ferintosh combined with visits to mum's with a view to her having weekends there.

On 13.1.95 Mandy departed for weekend leave as planned but failed to arrive at [REDACTED]. She telephoned Rossie and was returned to the secure unit. On the evening of 13.1.95 Mandy was giving staff cause for concern. She left the house and went walking around the buildings without informing anyone. [REDACTED] made the decision to place her in the secure building, because he felt there would be a risk leaving her in the open unit in case she ran away.

Mandy was given three options by [REDACTED] Depute C.E.O.:

1. Remain in Forth and co-operate with the programme laid out for her (including continued visits to mum).
2. An early Hearing would be called.
3. Return to secure and start from scratch, with no privileges.

Mandy chose the latter of the 3 and joined Tay Unit on 16.1.95.

This decision was no surprise to the staff who have worked with Mandy in the past. It was also recognised when she was in Lunan Unit that there was a risk of her becoming institutionalised.

As was said in the Hearing report, up until now Mandy has had no direction or purpose in her life and this is one of the reasons she clings to her peer group in Rossie, to give her a sense of belonging. Now that contact with mum has been established it is hoped that she may perhaps be able to focus her attention on rebuilding that relationship.

Highland Region are still offering a place for Mandy, not necessarily [REDACTED]

We look forward to discussing plans for Mandy's future at the forthcoming Review.

Events since last Hearing

As previously stated, Amanda attended a Children's Hearing in Dingwall on 17.8.94. Since that date Amanda once again started a programme of planned leave to [REDACTED]. Each leave would go ahead depending on how the last one went. At this

time Amanda was made fully aware of this. The first leave was planned for 26/28 August which seemed to go all right with Mandy returning to Rossie by train.

The next leave, 2/4 September, was unsuccessful due to Mandy not returning until 0230 hours on 3.9.94 instead of returning to [REDACTED] at 2130 hours the previous evening. Amanda was in a state of intoxication. Because of this she did not go on leave again until 16 September. Once again Mandy failed to return to [REDACTED] at the specified time, got drunk and was eventually apprehended by police. Amanda was returned to Rossie at approximately 0500 hours by [REDACTED] staff on the morning of 17 September. This latest incident gave Mandy a total of less than 24 hours out of Rossie. Since 17 September there has been no leave for Amanda, though she retains full privilege status.

### Rossie

Within Rossie Mandy continues to function as before. She is not a management problem and is very quiet around the unit. When discussing Mandy's problems with her she finds it very hard to give an explanation for her behaviour. Whilst out on leave the dangers of drinking are at her age have been explained to her in great detail, as have the obvious dangers for a young girl who is drunk out on the streets at all hours of the morning. Mandy doesn't seem to care what happens to her and cannot seem to take on board how dangerous a position she is putting herself in. We at Rossie feel that Mandy has shown very little commitment to ourselves or indeed Ferintosh. Mandy has now been with us for nearly 6 months and we clearly need to find a new direction for her if she is going to succeed in the future.

### Recommendation

It is quite obvious that Mandy is not making use of her placement in Rossie appropriately. While presenting us with no problems whatsoever within the building, it would appear that she is unable to exert any self control when outwith our care.

In Rossie she is now at the point of becoming totally institutionalised, letting everything be done for her and making no decisions that will alter her future.

We are at a loss as to know how to break this cycle other than to give her the ultimatum of withdrawing the place and frightening her into a response.

This said, her behaviour must be acknowledged to be no worse whilst on leave than many other youngsters who are not in secure accommodation.

We look forward to discussing her future options at the Review.

Amanda was returned to Rossie at approximately 0500 hours by [REDACTED] staff on the morning of 17 September. This latest incident gave Mandy a total of less than 24 hours out of Rossie.

As stated in previous reports Amanda continues to do well in Rossie and is not a management problem. She attends all classes willingly and her school reports are good. While discussing Mandy's problems she has had on various past leaves to [REDACTED] She finds it very hard to give an explanation for her behaviour. The dangers of a young girl who is drunk out on the streets at all hours of the morning have been explained to her in great detail and she now says that she wants to make a go of it at [REDACTED] and wants to get out of Rossie as soon as possible. We at Rossie would very much like her to succeed with her new plans.

On 11/10/94 a child in care review was held for Amanda within Rossie School. At this review all agencies concerned, noted Mandy's previous behaviour as detailed above. All felt at the time that although things have went wrong for Amanda in the past she should be given another chance to go on weekend leave to [REDACTED] as before each coming weekend leave would of course depend on how well or not the previous one went. Amanda has now started this leave programme and all staff report that the first one went very well. Also it was decided at the review that a recommendation for a further 3 month order would be made to Panel Members today. With a view to calling an early panel and having Amanda back home to [REDACTED] for Christmas. Everything of course is depending on her behaviour and conduct whilst on weekend leave at [REDACTED]

Recommendation - as said above we recommend to panel members that Amanda returns to Rossie for a further 3 month period. The reasons for this are:

1. To let Amanda prove that she can get more than one leave right.
2. Let Amanda show us that she can behave and modify her behaviour appropriately whilst on leave
3. Give Amanda a firm home base to return to for Christmas.

We look forward to discussing this report at today's Hearing.

However, workers from [REDACTED] did pass on that Amanda does suffer from psoriasis which now is thankfully cleared up. Apart from this, Amanda does suffer from the occasional sore head or sore stomach.

## Profile within Rossie

Amanda presents herself as a well built, tall young lady who takes a certain pride in her hygiene and well being. She eats and sleeps well and is settled into the unit with her peer group and staff alike. Amanda keeps herself busy during the evenings visiting Tay Unit, particularly one of the male residents there, whom Amanda has known for a number of years. Amanda is a likable young lady who hardly ever has to be reprimanded concerning bad behaviour or bad language. Saying this, she to a small degree has been involved in some of the 'winding up' and carrying on which is part of the everyday life in Rossie.

## Education

Amanda attends all classes willingly. An education report is attached.

## Outside Contacts

Amanda does not appear to keep in contact with any family outside Rossie whatsoever and her only real contact with home is [REDACTED] which she has 'phoned on numerous occasions.

## Ongoing Work

Since arriving in Rossie Amanda has discussed her past and her/

/her wishes for her future with her key worker. She has stated that the troubles she has had in the past have all been because she is involved with [REDACTED] and every time he gets into trouble so does she. She states that now she doesn't want to get into any more trouble or abscond and with this in mind her only wish is to return to [REDACTED] and get on with life as 'normal'.

Summary

Since arriving in Rossie Amanda has settled in well and has displayed no management or behavioural problems whatsoever. She has moved through our privilege system quickly and is now on full privileges. She does everything asked of her without complaint and is normally so quiet one would hardly think she is around at all. We believe she is beginning to face up to her problems re offending and absconding and is always ready to discuss each issue with her key worker. We at Rossie feel that now is the time to begin constructing a leave plan for Amanda to integrate her back into her own community. This would also give her a target to achieve and help her on her way to eventual return to the Inverness area, where, by her own admission, she clearly wishes to be.

We look forward to discussing this report at the Review.

## Profile within Rossie

Amanda presents herself as a well built, tall young lady who takes a certain pride in her hygiene and well being. She eats and sleeps well and most of the time is well settled in her unit with staff and peers alike. However, of late she has been most unsettled and has been one of the main instigators of winding up and carrying on in the unit. This has been particularly noticeable since she returned to Rossie from her absconsion which started on 7.7.94 and ended on 25.7.94, a total of 18 days, where by her own admission she had been sleeping rough in the woods, outside, etc. Mandy discussed why she never returned to Rossie at the correct time. Mandy states that although she did not mind going to [REDACTED] for leave she says that there is a member of staff there with whom she cannot communicate. [REDACTED]

██████████ discussed this issue with Amanda and explained that because she couldn't get on with a staff member at ██████████ all she had to do was tell her key worker upon return and he could inform all agencies concerned who would endeavour to overcome the problem. Another reason for her absconding is ██████████ whom she has had a long standing relationship with, but Mandy states that this relationship is now over and to date there has been no contact with ██████████ by 'phone or letter. Mandy's wishes for the future are now to get on a leave plan back to ██████████ and get on and make the most of it, stop absconding and eventually leave Rossie for ██████████ Mandy knows the recommendation we are making today. She knows the reasons for it and although she is not too happy about it she is realistic enough to know why we are making it.

#### Recommendation

We at Rossie feel that the only recommendation we can make in the light of recent events is that Mandy return to us for a further 3 months. Our reasons for this are:-

1. To give Mandy a period of stability.
2. Let Mandy come to terms realistically with her absconding.
3. Start Mandy on a leave programme once again and give her a home base for when she eventually leaves Rossie.
