Paul on his time away from Alberta has been going to his social work department for travel money or vouchers in get back to Alberta.

05/02/05 Paul went to Cheltenham when he supposed to be on his home visit. He spent all his money and went to the social work department in Gloucester to ask for a travel pass. After a number of calls to Alberta and [REDACTED], Paul got the pass.

17/02/05 Paul attended Pathways meeting with project Manager [REDACTED] and Project Leader [REDACTED] - see minutes 170205

18/02/05 Paul was informed his social work department would pay for a block of 15 driving lessons. Paul's family will also be given a 10 pound food voucher when he goes home for his home visits.

Staff have discussed this situation with Paul and the way he acts differently in front off peer [REDACTED] and the treatment towards peer [REDACTED], however since peer [REDACTED] has left Alberta Paul has apologized to peer [REDACTED] about this and expressed that he is now ready to make a fresh start know that peer [REDACTED] has left. Paul needs to do more paper work to show the social work department that he is committed to staying in Alberta however Paul has made more off an effort to get his paper work up to date. Paul did contact his social worker to say that he got a job. Paul seems to have a better relationship with his parents and there have been no problems. A driving instructor has been found and all Paul needs is to get is his provisional license.

Paul's Mum also highlighted that she wasn't happy with Paul's behavior and would like an emergency meeting. Paul's Mother was spoken to about the situation at home, and she is happy for Paul to continue to visit Dumfries however he has to live under their roof and rules.

19/05/05 Paul attended his review meeting and was giving another 6 Months funding. Paul has built up a good relationship with the new members of staff.

Paul has a good relationship with resident [REDACTED] and with his outside friends [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] however on the night of 10/05/05 Paul was involved in a fight, which included all five names of above against some local lads in the area. Paul was spoken to about the danger of having this kind of involvement with other lads in the area and the danger to himself and peers and the project. 30/05/05 Paul was out visiting his other friends and arrived back in to Alberta at 3:00am and he had been drinking.
