Another challenge to us all. At least Tyneholm are prepared to keep a base for [redacted] at the children's home, and even to have him back.

HM had length meeting with all W/H boys this evening, because of general deterioration in behaviour and lack of respect for staff.

Boys reasonably settled in school by lights out - Excellent report received on [redacted]

20.3.81 [redacted] to Hamilton Sh. Ct., as defence witness. Home visit thereafter (mother) then interview with Dep HM at Blantyre High School with a view to [redacted] resuming there after the Easter hols - 21 April.

[redacted] left school on T/W - starts work on Monday with Community Industry.

[redacted] sister's wedding. [redacted] invited as guest to reception, then overnight stay (till Sunday).

21.3.81 Twelve boys on week-end leave this morning, in addition to others last night, leaving 34 boys in school. All remaining boys on hit, with exception of nine boys off hit who attended Balrobie School Coffee Morning. Boys well behaved - enjoyable outing.

Day boy [redacted] arrived at 1 pm to stay in school overnight till Sunday 2pm.
