Mr McCallum discovered that certain boys had kept back money from Panda Law day and had asked the outworkers to bring in cigarettes, post letters etc. Boys had been out of bounds up trees on roofs when given free time in the estate.

8/4/81 Mr McCallum at training meeting in Kibble School. [redacted] & G Finnie to PRAI [redacted] [redacted] and [redacted] received visits from their social workers. Boxing ring set up in Paisley Town Hall but boys not allowed to go to show in the evening because of behaviour last night. Mr Munro attended hearing in Kilwinning with [redacted] - supervision continued and Mr Munro fixed up Ian Neill in employment. Outworkers [redacted] and [redacted] "sacked" because of the breach of trust regarding smuggling in cigarettes and posting "unofficial" letters. No recreation in houses in the evening and a thorough clean up of all houses took place.
