24.4.81 [redacted] attended Airdrie Sheriff Court with M on line. [redacted] and [redacted] attended PRAI for follow up treatment. The telephone engineers attended to re-site and replace the extension bell to the telephone in Mansion House. George Finnie's social worker (Mr M.A. Dale) visited the school to discuss future plans for George. Boxing ring was erected at Renfrew Town Hall. A party of boys attended the Manse Field in Beith in order to set up jumps for Beith Farmers Show tomorrow.

25.4.81. Party of boys to Beith Show did very well despite cold conditions. Boxing ring brought back from kinwood. School staffed in morning by 3 ladies, Mrs Gonsky, Miss Eldes, Miss O'Brien. Kite done a.m. In afternoon swimming, sports hall, sports field, indoor rec. Some working party boys granted leave P.M. (Worked a volunteer policy) also 3 boys who washed dishes very unwillingly sent to cinema with [redacted] whose visit did not arrive. Visit rearranged to later date. Boys in all houses allowed to see film until 12.30pm.

* At 10.30pm. Mr. McCallum received telephone call from Mr. Cullen, Night Care Officer who was on duty in W/V house. Due to a minor incident with [redacted], Mr. Cullen was in a state of extreme anxiety. His face was drained of colour, lips white & was freely perspiring from forehead. I sent Mr Cullen over to T/H to have a coffee & settle down and sent the lad to bed. I stayed in house for 30 mins. When Mr. Cullen returned he threw a bundle on the table and asked that I get the lad up to go to the S/Hall with Mr. Cullen to settle the dispute. Quite frankly I was completely taken
