House meetings in afternoon focussed on deteriorating relationships between staff / boys in all houses, but especially two boys - [redacted] and [redacted] both seen by H/M early evening.

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[redacted] did not attend the interview which had been arranged for him as he had been involved in offences when on leave last week-end. The cans and flags for the flag day tomorrow were delivered by Strathclyde Youth Club Association and the twenty-four volunteers were briefed by Mr Neil and later by Mr McCallum re. the techniques of collecting for charity.

Mr Hair, social worker visited [redacted]. Very few boys were sent on leave as many boys had volunteered to go on the flag day. Headmaster and Mr Roy attended Ayr ^{High} Sheriff Court for the continuing trial of [redacted] and [redacted]. The doctor visited the school in the afternoon.
