Hi there,

I attach a letter and documents in response to the above enquiry. Although we carried out a full search, I have only been able to find admissions information extant for Mr Paterson. Unfortunately the period in question, the 1980s to mid-90s, tends to be poor in surviving records. This appears to be because earlier records were kept in large ledgers which were difficult to dispose of. Paper records from the 1980s were often kept in individual files which were frequently passed on to Social Work when an individual left our care settings, without a backup being kept, or were simply destroyed after a time as obsolete. This changed when data protection legislation came in, but this was too late for some individuals' records.
