6.3.85 Days events as per diary. Mr McCullum etc till 5pm. then Mr Walker (Mr Neil on holiday). Admonition of [redacted]. [redacted] attended Aicne Jn. Court - [redacted] and [redacted] appeared from custody, on petition. Remanded in custody till next week. [redacted] returned from sick leave. Only three staff on in evening, one of those being stand-in relief Mr Miller. Mr Ken assisted by staying on in W/House. Smoke detector removed from upstairs red corridor area and fire discovered in cupboard - broom handles and brushes. A meeting proceeded with all boys, covering all the hazards and dangers of fire. Warning that cigarettes and matches may have to be withdrawn, and that the matter would be reported to H/M. [redacted] considered to be the suspect. Boasting to others of his previous involvement on arson charge. Night staff asked to be more vigilant + tonight because of this incident. Mr. Beath also alerted. Trouble at bed-time in W/H. Doms 5+6 beds barricaded against doors. Both baths in toilet area overflowing, with boys towels in baths, and
