Hi Francesca we spoke on Wednesday 12th August 2026 as I wanted to put application to the Scottish redress scheme for the time I was in forteviot house, assessment centre also Guthrie's, you then emailed me to let me know you have now passed my application onto Scottish redress scheme. after we spoke there were couple of things that I didn't tell you, Francesca would it be possible for what iam going to tell you can be forwarded to the Scottish redress scheme to support my application that you put inn.

Francesca I don't know if I was sexually abused or not as at the time i was being sexually abused by my uncle I may or may not have been sexually abused whilst under supervision of the assessment center and forteviot house while in forteviot there was a member of staff called Mr Campbell who used to take myself and 2 others to a large padded room to play in that room there was different shapes of soft blocks when I jumped into the soft blocks if cushions mr Campbell used to touch my thigh on few occasions while in the soft room.

I can also remember the time I spent in assessment centre there was only 3 of us in then the other 2 were in for murder for what I remember it wasn't a nice place to be inn as the other 2 boys were older than me and sort of picked on me as I was only a small thin boy then it was certainly scary as the staff done nothing about it coming from forteviot witch was run by medical staff then put in with 2 murderers in assessment center I still state to this day I shouldn't have been placed in there after forteviot house the staff members were so cruel to me the verbal and physical abuse was bad Used to get hit over the head with there hand or you were kicked up the bum it wasn't just a soft hit it was hard iam sure I already told you about at night when locked up in my bedroom we didn't have a toilet in the bedroom if I needed the toilet I had to press the buzzer to get out to use toilet many times during the night we didn't get out to use toilet times I wet the bed the staff told me I had to wait till morning to get clean sheets so i had no option but to sleep in the wet bed if I kept on ringing the buzzer to get clean sheets or needed the toilet the verbal abuse was shocking iam not saying all the staff were bad and iam not saying I was perfect but I didn't deserve to be treated Like a animal all this was terrifying it really was as I said before I don't understand why I was taken to assessment center from forteviot house it was a massive jump it really was and being sent to Guthrie's was just as bad iam sure I've already told you about Guthrie's the verbal and physical in there ad shocking it really was as I've said before I was only a small thin boy then I got picked alot staff done nothing I used to get hit over the head by a clogg as we had to line up and if I wasn't standing straight mr macabe would hit me or slap me I went through so much while in Guthrie's honestly it wasn't nice I was just a young boy who was having alot of family problems outside you would think the staff would help me but I got no help, everything that I experienced while in forteviot, assessment center, Guthrie's has and always will affect me I've kept all this inside the box I built inside my head back then I told no one also what the staff done to me I thought it was right what they were doing I was only a young little disturbed boy, Francesca since I told you about things I've not been doing so go I've had to open up to my carer he is doing a referral so I can receive counseling everything I said to you on the telephone the other day it's opening the boxes that I've built in my head and it's not nice as all I do now is think about my past,, Francesca iam

sorry that my email is long iam better explaining things on paper or writing it,is it possible to add this to my application that you have done for me,
