The staff situation in the morning was really acute. The boy returned satisfactorily. The Dalkeith Police interviewed [redacted] and the Saltcoats Police [redacted] in connection with possible offences committed whilst on leave. Both denied any involvement or knowledge. Miss Henderson, L.A.S.W., visited [redacted] and then returned him to the Children's Home in Largo.
