Five boys due for D/P tomorrow: [redacted] and [redacted] (M/H), [redacted] and [redacted] (W/H) and Wm. Eeder (N/V). All 3 houses reasonably settled this evening, with home recreation, T.V. and video. AVW

2-11-85

Four boys on D/pans, leaving eight boys in school. All boys to Community Centre in Beith to help erect staging for concert. B. Shaw washed school car. Outing to football in afternoon, and visit by Mr Walker and B. Shaw to [redacted] at Langriggend. Outing to Cinema in the evening with Mr McLeod, spoiled by [redacted] absconding. News received of S. Martin in custody of Police at Plymouth - referred to JLF Stand-by Service. Boy will likely remain in care of SS Dept till Monday when escort will be arranged. [redacted] phoned wishing to return from leave, after trouble at home. Boy collected in Saltcoats by Mr Geddes. [redacted] mother phoned saying boy stayed out all Fri. night (as he has done on two previous occasions). Doesn't wish boy to get leave next week-end. [redacted] back from D/pans at 11.25 pm, but [redacted] still unaccounted for. Will not conclude till after midnight. AVW
